Street and Recycling Committee Meeting
May 11, 2009
Board Room – Edgar Village Hall

Call to Order – Roll Call. The Street and Recycling Committee meeting was called to order by Chair Tom Sommer at 6:30 P.M. Committee members Terry Lepak, Allen Huebsch and Barkley Anderson, Village Administrator were present. Paul Schilling, Allan King, Todd Brinkman and Mike Bergs were also present.

Agenda Approval. Motion by T. Lepak second by A. Huebsch to approve the agenda as written. 3 yes, 0 no. Motion carried.

B&D Fabricator request a second driveway along Chesak Avenue. Todd Brinkman spoke on behalf of B&D Fabricator's. Motion by A. Huebsch second T. Lepak to recommend to Village Board to leave temporary culvert there and to put permanent culvert on timeline with building addition and current agreement with T&E and Village of Edgar. T&E will maintain temporary culvert and secure village permit. 3 yes, 0 no. Motion carried.

Request by Patti & David Schuett to raise service box located at 909 Clearview Court. Motion by T. Sommer second by T. Lepak to recommend to Village Board to fill area around service box in the Village right-of-away with black dirt. 3 yes, 0 no. Motion carried.

Allan King Curb & Gutter. Motion by T. Sommer second by T. Lepak to recommend to Village Board to have Melvin Company inspect and repair curb and gutter. 3 yes, 0 no. Motion carried.

St. John's Church Curb. Motion by A. Huebsch second by T. Sommer to recommend to Village Board to send letter to St. John's Church requesting that they replace the curb and gutter in front of the church and school. 3 yes, 0 no. Motion carried.

Sidewalk Marking & Billing For Service. Motion by T. Sommer second by T. Lepak to recommend to Village Board to mark sidewalks, get estimates on repair, send letter to property owners allowing option of replacing on their own and what it will cost if Village repairs. If owner replaces they have an August 1st deadline to get work completed or Village will replace. Also explain sidewalk replacement can be specially assessed with a 3 year payment schedule. 3 yes, 0 no. Motion carried.

Two Block Street Repair. Motion by A. Huebsch second by T. Lepak to recommend to Village Board that two blocks of 1st Avenue from Oak Street to Elm Street to be repaired at the cost of \$30,000. 3 yes, 0 no. Motion carried.

Informational Sign. Motion by T. Lepak second by A. Huebsch to recommend to Village Board to have that a sign be placed at the concrete pile in industrial park that restricts dumping of unwanted material. 3 yes, 0 no. Motion carried.

Chip Sealing. Village will slag seal 4 ½ blocks –Birch from 3rd to 2nd, 2nd between Birch and Maple, Maple from 3rd to 1st. The Village will crack seal north half of village (north of Redwood).

Adjournment. Motion by T. Lepak second by A. Huebsch to adjourn. 3 yes, 0 no. Motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 7:30 P.M.
